CONSENT to Chapters

Your application for Society approval of your plan for incorporation having satisfied the requirements of the Society, consent is hereby given to you to proceed with such incorporation in accordance with the plan as set forth in the Resolutions adopted at your meeting on February 2, 1948.

This consent is revocable by the Society should you in any respect depart from your plan of organization as submitted and is conditioned upon your agreement and that of the corporation that such incorporated chapter shall continue its affiliation with the Society, subject to the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and rules of the Society from time to time promulgated by the Society for the conduct of the affairs of the Society, its Chapters and Members, and that upon termination of such affiliation for any cause, said corporation shall be dissolved.
